

As you may know, the KML Science Fair is Friday, April 4th. The Bethlehem Science Fair will occur on the days before and after the KML Science Fair. **Projects will have to be fully completed and brought to school on Tuesday, April 2nd**. They will be judged Tuesday or Wednesday (April 2nd and 3rd) night. The 10 projects that are chosen to go to KML will be transported to KML on Thursday or Friday. The remaining projects will remain in the south campus gym over the weekend and may be seen and taken home after the weekend church services. The KML Science Fair projects may be seen at KML on Friday night.

Because this is part of Bethlehem's science curriculum, all students in grades 5-8 will do a project. Limited help from parents is encouraged! Students may not work with other students on the projects. During the week students will be required to present and explain their project to the class as part of their grade in Science.

The following is a list of benchmark dates and objectives that will help the students get their projects done on time. Although teachers may not be checking, the items and dates below are designed to encourage steady progress toward completion of an excellent science project.

| By Monday, March 31, 2008 | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Final revisions and typing of report complete.2. Presentation project board should be almost done.3. Students can bring project to school.4. Put finishing touches on at school or at home. |
| On Tuesday, April 1, 2008 | Project should be completed and left at school by 3:00 PM (for judging on Tuesday or Wednesday). |
| By Friday, April 4, 2008 | <i>Winning Science Projects from Bethlehem Science Fair transported to KML times TBA.</i> |
