Your child has learned of the joyful responses several different people gave when they heard of the promised Savior's birth.

But today your child heard about another person's response to Jesus' birth—a response that was far from joyful! King Herod hated Jesus and even tried to kill him.

The Holy Spirit, through Baptism and God's Word, has given you and your child faith in Jesus. But many people reject him. Pray that your family is always among those who love Jesus and rejoice in him!

Here's an idea for a family activity: Go on a treasure hunt. Hunt for objects in your home that reflect your family's love for Jesus (Bible, church bulletin, offering envelopes, Jesus videos, hymnal, cross, etc.). Gather your objects and discuss how they reflect your love for Jesus. (Examples: Bible—we learn about Jesus; church bulletin—we worship Jesus together; offering envelopes—we give Jesus gifts; etc.)

Prayer

Dear Holy Spirit, thank you for giving us faith in Jesus as our Savior and King. Please strengthen that faith so that we always love Jesus, our King. Amen.
