[Where does the Egg Hunt take place?](#)

[What time does the Egg Hunt begin?](#)

Registration and pre-activities go from 8:30am to 9:30am.

Egg Hunt and activities begin promptly at 9:30am and will go until 10:30am.

Plan to arrive early to avoid disappointment.

[Is the Egg Hunt indoors?](#)

Yes, the event will be held in the gymnasium.

[What is the cost?](#)

Nothing. The egg hunt and all activities are offered free of charge.

[What time should our family arrive?](#)

Aim to arrive between 8:30am-9:15am. The egg hunt will begin at 9:30am sharp.

[Does my child need to bring a basket?](#)

No, we provide bags for each participating child.

[Do we need to pre-register?](#)

No, however, each family **MUST** fill out a registration form at arrival which includes an accident waiver and permission to photograph your child.

[What are the ages of participation?](#)

Ages 2-11 may participate.

[Are parents able to help their children in the egg hunt patch?](#)

Parents of younger children (ages 2-5) are permitted to help their child in the egg hunt patch.

[What kinds of items are in the plastic eggs?](#)

Peanut/Nut-free candy, small toys, stickers, tattoos, bracelets.

[How does the Egg Hunt work?](#)

We cannot fit all participating children into the egg hunt patch at once. So we split the children up into 3 age groups (ages 2-5; 6-8; and 9-11). While one group is hunting, the other two groups will be doing other fun activities (see the schedule on the next page). Each child will receive a map (appropriate to his/her age group) that will help guide them to all the activity stations. Parents of the younger groups are encouraged to accompany their children to all the stations.

[How many eggs will there be?](#)

There will be 4300 eggs total. Each age group will have 1400 to find when it is their turn.

[What is the egg hunt patch made of?](#)

Our custom-made egg hunt patch is filled with thinly shredded paper to give it a festive grassy look which also makes it more challenging for the children to find the eggs.

[What are the other activities?](#)

Aside from the Egg Hunt, the children will have the opportunity to hear the Easter story and make an Easter-related craft.
